Sqoop is a collection of related tools. To use Sqoop, you specify the tool you want to use and the arguments that control the tool. If Sqoop is compiled from its own source, you can run Sqoop without a formal installation process by running the bin/sqoop program. Users of a packaged deployment of Sqoop (such as an RPM shipped with Apache Bigtop) will see this program installed as /usr/bin/sqoop.
