William Ouchi developed Theory Z after making a comparative study of Japanese and American management practices. Theory Z is an integrated model of motivation. Theory Z suggests that large complex organisations are human systems and their effectiveness depends on the quality of humanism used. A type Z organisation has three major features—trust, subtlety and intimacy.

### William Ouchi's Theory Z of Motivation: Features and ...

According to Ouchi, Theory Z management tends to promote stable employment, high productivity, and high employee morale and satisfaction. "Japanese Management" and Theory Z itself were based on Dr. W. Edwards Deming 's famous " 14 points ". Deming, an American scholar whose management and motivation theories were more popular outside the United States, helped lay the foundation of Japanese organizational development during their expansion in the world economy in the 1980s.

Theory Z was developed by William Ouchi in 1981. It describes the major postulates of Japanese management practices and how these practices can be adopted to the environment of United States and other countries. It provides a complete transformation of motivational aspect of employees which other theories are not able to emphasize.

Theory Z states that productivity is dependent on trust, subtlety, and intimacy. (Ouchi, 2003) Japanese organization includes lifetime employment; promotions are from within and employees remain until mandatory retirement age.
